

Basics of Fall Protection: *Trainer's Guide* (M054)

Evaluation Questionnaire

Question 1: In the revised *User's Guide*, the question, answers, and illustration have all been changed. The correct answer is now (b).

Question 3: In the revised *User's Guide*, the illustration in CHOICE "A" has been changed. The correct answer is still (a).

Question 7: In the revised *User's Guide*, the question now reads, "It is recommended that the anchor point in a fall-arrest system should be able to support the weight of a small car (about 3600 pounds)." The correct answer is still TRUE.

Question 8: In the revised *User's Guide*, all three illustrations have been changed. The correct answer is still (a).

Question 12: In the revised *User's Guide*, the question now reads, "Select the type and size of material typically used as a vertical lifeline." The correct answer is still (b).

Question 13: In the revised *User's Guide*, the illustration has been changed. The correct answer is still (c).

Question 14: In the revised *User's Guide*, "foot" now reads "metre" and "feet" now reads "metres." The correct answer is still (c).

Question 16: In the revised *User's Guide*, the illustration has been changed. The correct answer is still (c).

Question 20: In the revised *User's Guide*, answer (a) now reads, "be fully planked at heights of 2.4 metres or greater." The correct answer is still (d).
